



What is a credit ?


- **Credit** = theoretical measure for learning
- 1 credit = ~ **30 hours** of learning activities
- 1 academic year = 60 credits
- ~ 42 weeks/year, ~ 42 hours of learning activities per week



- <u>Transcripts from your final year of secondary</u> education (Baccalaureate transcript)*
- High School Diploma*
- Proof of equivalence request.
- Any available higher education transcripts.

• No language proficiency proof required EXCEPT for: Bachelor's in Economic Sciences or Business Engineering taught in English. Bachelors in Law, Languages, Literature, Translation, and Communication.

Note: For students in their final year of secondary education, a proof of enrollment for the last year is temporarily sufficient.

- Identity document (identification card or passport)
- Identity photo (in ID card format for the issuance of your student card)
- Transcripts for each year of higher education
 undertaken
- First-cycle diplomas (Bachelor's, License, etc.) or other Master's degrees*
- Proof of language proficiency for didactic Master's programs or certain other Master's programs (Multilingual Communication, Journalism, etc.)

Note: For students in their final year of a degree program, a proof of enrollment for the current year is temporarily sufficient

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor's Degree (First Cycle)

<u>Criteria Imposed by the Central Admission Committee</u> <u>for First-Cycle Programs</u>

- Overall average of 13/20
- <u>Minimum grades of 12/20 required in all specific</u> <u>subjects related to the application</u>
- <u>Successful completion of all years of study</u> <u>undertaken after obtaining the secondary school</u> <u>diploma, with a minimum average of 13/20 and</u> <u>passing all subjects in the curriculum</u>
- Obtaining the equivalency certificate allowing access to the desired studies, issued by the equivalency service
- Providing proof to the equivalency service that you are eligible for the desired studies in your home country (e.g., transcripts if studies have been undertaken, admission or selection certificate, etc.)

Master's Degree (Second Cycle)

- Grade criteria and Average Score Requirements Set by the Jury (accessible on the information page of the master's program to which you intend to apply)
- Language proficiency level (if required by the jury in the access conditions)



European and non-European distinction







Visa (general)

- Visa application with your local Belgian embassy or consulate
- Required documents :
- Admission letter
- Passport
- Proof of sufficient financial resources
- Health insurance (*mutuelle*)
- Formulaire standard
- **Deadline :** as soon as possible (one month in advance AT THE LATEST)





- Admission letter : letter delivered by the ULB on the online application platform (when you receive it, to be added to visa application if still in progress)
- Proof of sufficient financial resources
- Scholarship certificate
- A commitment by a guarantor to take charge of the student (called Annexe 32). The guarantor must fulfill precise conditions
- Solvency Certificate (blocked account certificate)

• Health insurance

- Private Schengen-type health insurance taken in your home country, valid for at least 3 months after your arrival in Belgium
- Certificate of a Belgian health insurance (*mutuelle*) that certifies you will be registered with them at your arrival





- Your accommodation must allow for domiciliation : domiciliation is the obligation to register with your local municipality (*commune*) with the address of the accommodation you are renting in your own name. It is normally always possible to be domiciliated in Belgium with a rented accommodation, unless it is explicitly specified in your rental agreement that domiciliation is not possible. If you have any doubt, please ask the landlord before signing your rental agreement

Accommodation in Brussels





- Make an appointment with your local town-hall : visit the website of your town-hall to check how you should make an appointment (by phone, by email or online)
- Required documents for your appointment:

-Passport
-ULB registration letter
-Proof of sufficient financial resources
>guarantor
>scholarship
>or a blocked account
-Health insurance certificate (mutuelle)
-Formulaire standard



Annexe 15

- The local police will visit you and check that you do reside at the address you provided (do not forget to put your name on the bell and the letter-box)
- Your residence permit : you will first receive the codes of your residence card by post, and then you go to your local town-hall to collect your card (instructions for this will be provided with the codes)



Registration with your local municipality (commune)



- Mandatory registration covers your health costs in Belgium
- Many companies : *Partenamut, Mutualité Chrétienne, CAAMI...* compare them <u>here</u>
- The cost and cover varie according to the insurance company you choose, but for each health expense, always a part remaining at your charge

Open a bank account

- Many banks : ING, BNP, Belfius... compare them here
- To open a Belgian bank account you must first have received the Annexe 15 (document issued by your municipalty/commune, other required documents : passport/identity card (for European citizens), ULB registration letter, rental contract
- To open a bank account earlier even before moving to Belgium, you can open an online bank account with a neo-bank : Revolut, Wise, Nickel, etc.
- **Deadline :** as soon as possible
